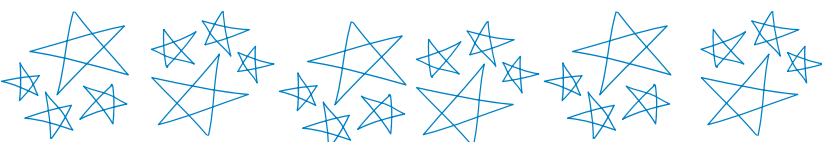

In September, we expanded our remarkably successful literacy program to serve more members. All kindergarten - sixth graders participated in a FALL Literacy Assessment, increasing the number enrolled in Comprehensive Literacy Instruction from 306 in 2017-2018 to the current number of 669 kids.
