Rising STEM Talent

Through a \$10,000 grant from the Sea Research Foundation (SRF), eight of our teen Youth Mentors from the STEM Mentoring program visited the Peer Mentor Leadership Academy (PMLA) June 24-28 in Mystic, Connecticut. Our Youth Mentors, who were chosen based on demonstrated leadership and a desire to improve relationship building skills, participated in programming at Mitchell College and visited several natural science attractions and museums.



The PMLA prepares teens to assist in leading the STEM Mentoring program at the Clubs. The STEM Mentoring program utilizes the Sea Research curriculum that brings together youth and adult community mentors for fun, hands-on STEM activities with a focus on conservation. Units include renewable energy, endangered species, water conservation, recycling, and more.

2019 Scholarship Recipients

Each year, our graduating Club seniors and alumni have the opportunity to apply for and renew the Lenzmeier, Nigon, Nicholson, Voyageur, and BGCTC post-secondary scholarships. A total of **\$90,000** in scholarships was awarded to **33** Club graduates and alumni

this year, an increase from 18 recipients in 2018.
