BGCTC's holistic Teen Pathways Life & Workforce Readiness program provides tailored education and resources to guide young people as they discover and build skills and interests, learn how to apply their skills and interests to the future workforce, and prepare for and connect to workforce opportunities.

Grades 6-12 age tracks include activities in nine developmental areas:

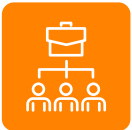
Teen Pathways Database
