HOUSING

Campers stay in cabins with 10-12 campers and two staff members. Each cabin has a bathroom, bunk beds, and a separate counselor loft.

MEDICATION

All medications that camp youth need for their week at camp needs to be turned into a camp representative. The medications need to be **in the original labeled pharmaceutical container**. These medications will be locked at all times, unless being administered. Please fill out the medication info section found on the camp registration form.

If your youth has special dietary needs, please make sure to fill that out on the **camp permission slip** and inform the camp director prior to your youth's camp session.

TRANSPORTATION

Voyageur provides transportation to and from camp. There will be two bus stops, one in Minneapolis at the Jerry Gamble Club site: 2410 N Irving Ave, Minneapolis, MN 55412410. The second is at the Mt. Airy club site: 690 Jackson St, St Paul, MN 55130. Buses will leave promptly at **11:00 am on Monday** and will return **1:00 pm on Friday**.
